

PRODUCT WARRANTY

LASERLITE APOLLO

PROFILED POLYCARBONATE SHEET

Laserlite Australia Pty Ltd (hereinafter called "Laser") warrants the original purchasers of Laserlite Apollo Polycarbonate Sheet (hereinafter referred to as "the product") that the product is free from defects due to faulty manufacture or workmanship and are warranted.

1. Loss of Light Transmission - Lifetime Warranty

The product will not lose more than 8% of light transmission for the first 10 years and thereafter no more than 1% per year for lifetime from the purchase date (when tested in accordance with ASTM D 1003-1995).

2. Weather Breakage - 5 Year Warranty

For a period of 5 years not to break or fracture as a result of the impact of hail measuring up to 25mm in diameter. Damage caused by the impact of objects other than hail is excluded from this warranty.

Subject to the matters referred to below, this Warranty applies from the date of original purchase and is valid to the original purchaser only. The benefit of the Warranty cannot be transferred to anyone else and only applies to domestic applications. This Warranty applies only to product that is stored, installed and cleaned in accordance with Laser's recommendations. This Warranty does not apply to any sheet which has been scratched or similarly damaged whether by accident, vandalism, fire or other like causes. The Warranty does not apply if any sheet has not been cleaned in accordance with Laser's recommendations and in particular, if loss of light transmission has been caused by accumulation of dirt or use of chemicals, paint or other substances. This Warranty does not cover installation or related expenses or any other direct or indirect loss(es) which may result from product failure and Laser will not by virtue of this Warranty be liable in contract or in tort for any consequential indirect or special damage or loss of any kind whatever. All claims made under the warranty must be notified to Laser in writing and be accompanied by proof of purchase as specified below. Following inspection of the failed product by an authorised Laser representative the failed sheet of the product should be returned to Laser. Prior to measuring the light transmission and impact resistance, the product must be cleaned in accordance with Laser's recommendations so the tests referred to above can be carried out. All claims made pursuant to this Warranty should be made in writing to the Product Manager, Laserlite Australia Pty Ltd., 17-19 Wangara Road, Cheltenham, Vic 3192 and should include a copy of the original purchase documentation or reasonable evidence of the original purchase date. Unless and to the extent expressly prohibited by legislation such as the Trade Practices Act 1974 which cannot be excluded or modified, the liability of Laser for a breach of any condition or warranty shall be limited to the replacement of the failed sheet of the product or to the supply of an equivalent product or to the cost of replacing the failed product or of acquiring an equivalent product.
